Vacation Club is open from 8am - 6pm each day. Please ensure your child brings a healthy packed lunch, snacks, a water bottle, hat, and spare clothes for the day. We'll provide afternoon fruit every day.

### Terms and Conditions

- Remember that on cooking days, children will be making their own food to share.
- All our services have a no-hat, no playing outside policy that will be adhered to at all times.
- It is a workplace health and safety requirement that children wear covered shoes at our services for safe playing.
- Do not bring any electronic devices, including smartwatches, switches, tablets, or mobile phones to our services under any circumstances.
- We provide a wide range of fun and engaging activities for all children, and there is no need for your child to bring a device for their own entertainment. If you want to contact your child during the day, you are welcome to call or SMS our service number, and our staff will relay your messages.

### Excursions:

- On excursion day, please be at the service 30 minutes before the designated departure time.
- Excursions are compulsory, and our service is closed on those days.
- Excursion and workshops costs listed are additional to daily fees. **For this program the Bounce session will cost \$55 on top of the regular session fee.** Childcare subsidies apply to all excursion and workshops costs (based on family Centrelink entitlements and eligibility).
